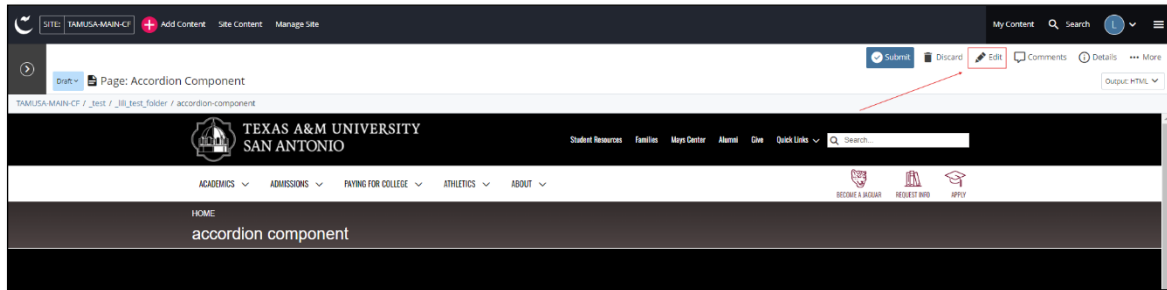


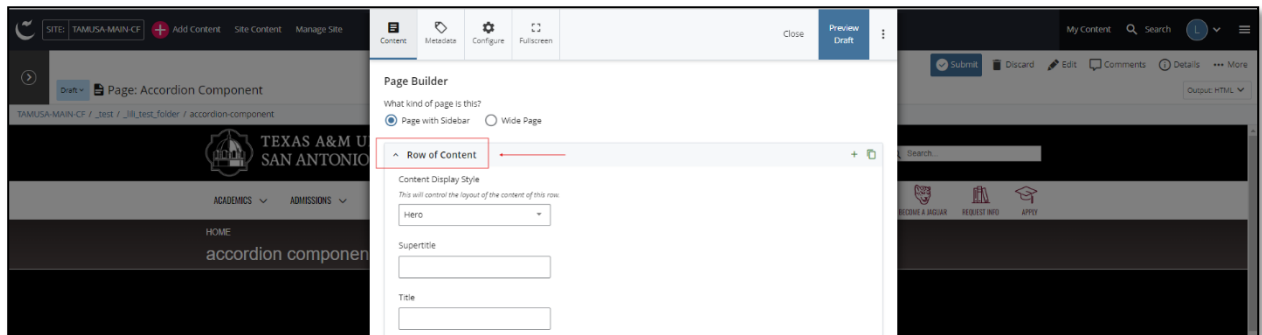
Accordion Component

This document will explain how to use the “**Accordion Component**”:

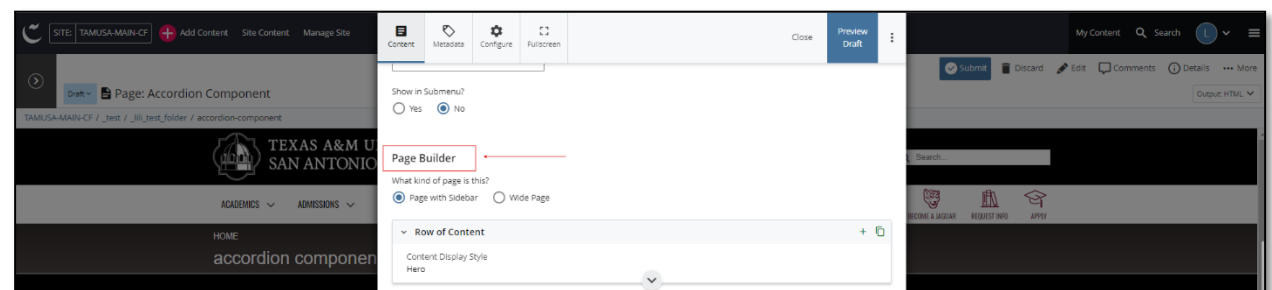
1. Click the ‘**Edit**’ button, top right of the screen.



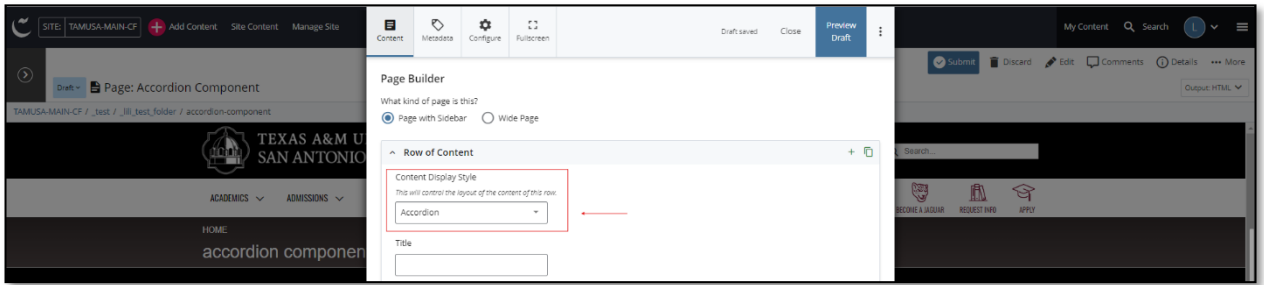
2. Navigate to “**Page Builder**” section, near the middle of the screen.



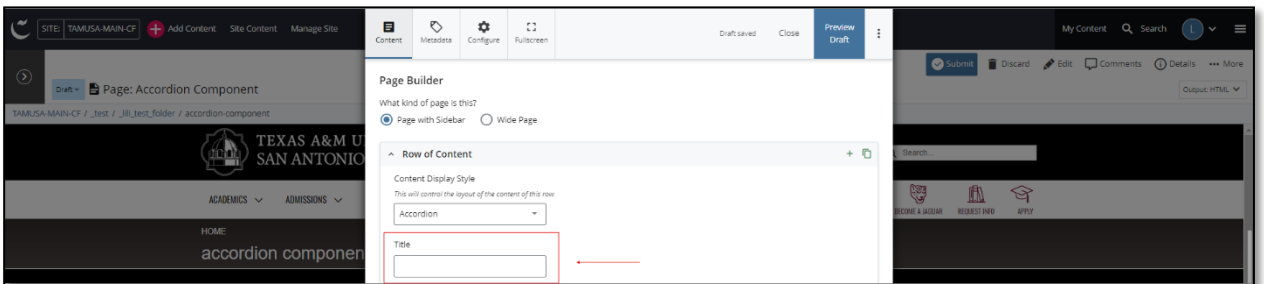
3. Open the **Row of Content** pane by clicking the carrot to the left of the **Row of Content** title.



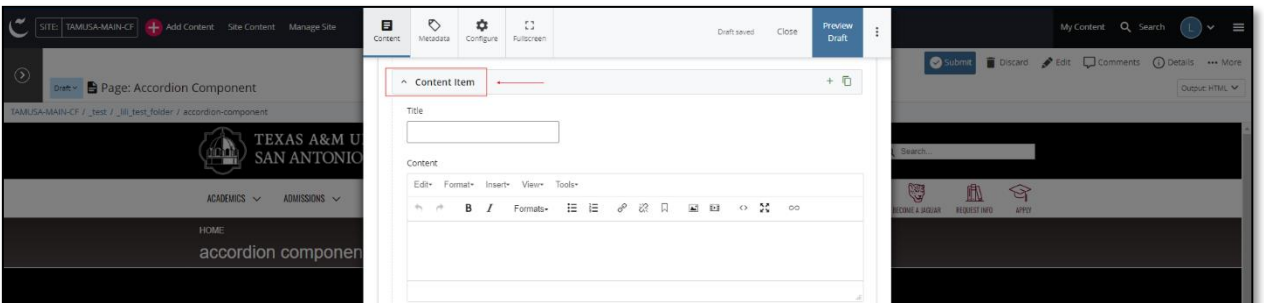
4. Open the **Content Display Style** pulldown and select the **Accordion** option.



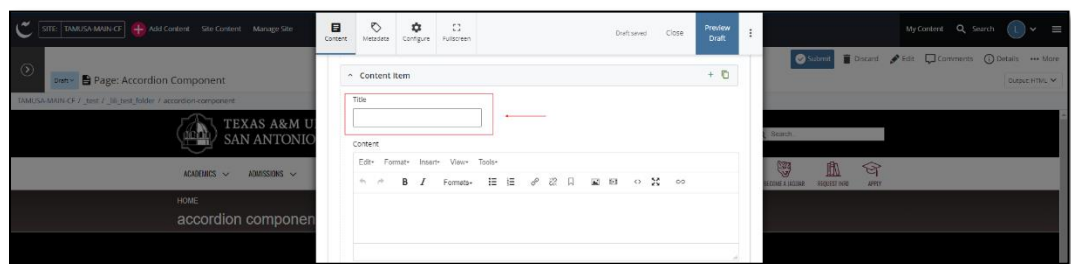
5. Fill out the **Title** block.



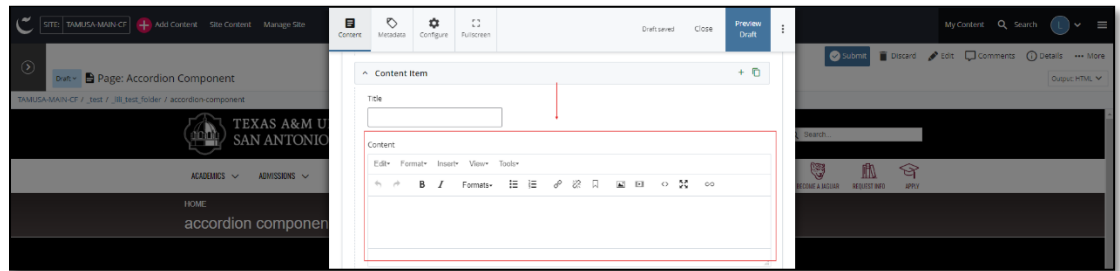
6. Expand and complete the **Content Item** section.



- a. Fill out the **Title** block.

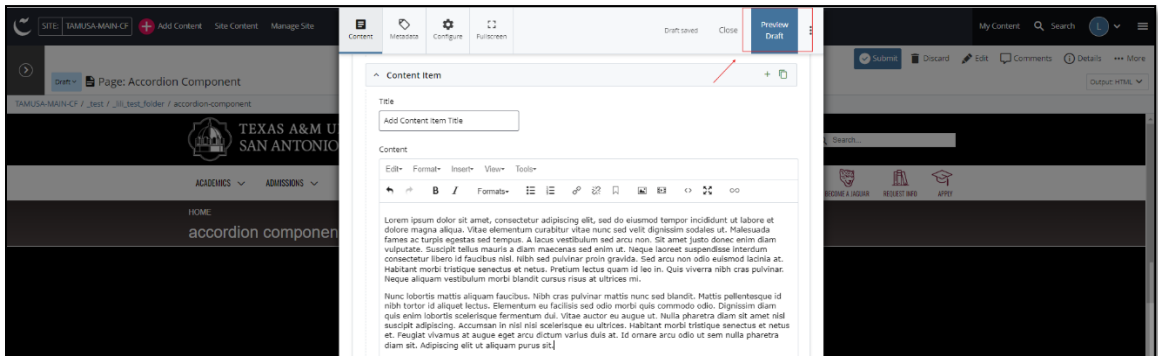


b. Complete the **Content** block.

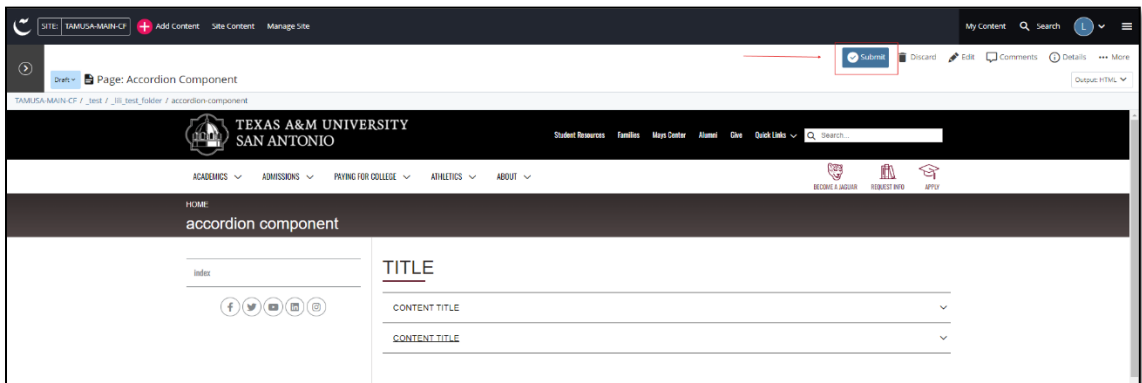


i. *This block has a WYSIWYG to format and edit the content in the content block. WYSIWYGs will be explained in another video.*

7. After making edits, click on the **Preview Draft** button.



8. If you like what you've created click on the **Submit** button otherwise click on the **Edit** button if you'd like to continue to make changes.
