NSF S-STEM Scholarship

Texas A&M University-San Antonio has been awarded by the NSF S-STEM program to support high-achieving students in STEM majors with demonstrated financial need. Over the next five years, starting from Fall 2021, the program will fund 11 students each year, at \$7,091 each. Eligible students must major in the following degree programs: Biology, Water Resources Science and Technology, Mathematics, and Electronic System and Engineering Technology. The scholarships may be renewable, subject to the evaluation by the

designated scholarship committee. S-STEM scholarship recipients are required to actively participate in faculty-led research and other faculty-mentored activities.

- ▶ Eligibility: First-Year and Third-Year (including transfer), full-time students
- Minimum GPA: 3.0
- Application: Est. announcement in mid to later April. Please check with the Office of Scholarship and Financial Aid.
